what is PAD?

Peripheral Arterial Disease involves artery blockage in the extremities of the body. There are many reasons for artery blockage; however, cholesterol deposition is usually to blame. Risk factors associated with blockages include increased age, diabetes, elevated cholesterol, high blood pressure, smoking and a family history. Leg cramps, particularly with walking (claudication), leg pain at rest, cold feet, numbness, loss of hair on the legs, and difficulty in wound healing are symptoms and signs of this condition.

Presence of PAD doubles death rate,iliac PAD raises death rate five fMortality rates at 5 years for patients older than 75 was 52% in diabetic patients, 38% in nondiabetic. Mortality rates at 5 years for patients younger than 75 was 23% in diabetic, 10% in nondiabetic.¹

Screening is a process where a non invasive test is done to warrant whether further testing is needed. For PAD, screening includes measurement of ABI and or TBI along with measurement of calf circumference. These data points will be examined by a doctor to determine whether a patient has a high probability of PAD and if further diagnostic testing is necessary. Screening is not a diagnostic test, it is simply a tool that may detect an abnormality which can then be examined by a doctor to determine the causation of the abnormality.
